

Instructions for District 5080 Rotary Youth Exchange Program Preliminary Application

Instructions for Student and Parents

- Both the student and parent need to sign this Preliminary Application (which includes the Country Preference form)
- By October 1, deliver one original signed application (consider making a copy for yourself) and submit to your local Rotary (NOTE: the local Rotary Club will meet in person with the student and parents regarding this application). The Rotary Club should make a copy for their records and send the original to the Youth Exchange Office.
- Note that Rotary Exchange programs require students to have received immunizations against common childhood diseases and in some cases countries may require additional immunizations.
- Note that the cost of the exchange is established each year and if accepted as an exchange student, fees will be due in accordance with the established schedule, which is presented below. Note that limited financial assistance is available through the Conger Memorial Scholarship Fund; however funds awarded through this fund do not affect your obligations stated in the Financial Agreement.

Completing Your Application Using our Fillable Savable Form

The application is a computer-generated application. You *must* complete this application on the computer. *If your application is not completed on the computer using the most current version of this application, your application will be returned.*

First, open the form on your computer. Second, use "save as" to save the form in a location where you can easily locate the application again. Third, complete the information requested in each of the fillable blanks on your computer and use "save" to save it on your computer. You must answer all questions completely and as asked (*do not* write "same," "see above," or "see page ___"). Make sure to use correct grammar and spelling. **After you have saved the completed form on your computer, print one (1) copy of the computer-generated application, sign.**

(1) Required visit to embassy for Canadian Students (Croatia->Ottawa; Italy, Belgium->Vancouver or Calgary; Chile, Ecuador, Greece-> Vancouver.)

(2) Required visit to embassy for US Students (Chile, France, Italy, Denmark, Greece-> San Francisco; Belgium->Los Angeles. Ecuador ->Las Vegas; Los Angeles, Minneapolis or San Francisco; Croatia->Seattle)

(3) Mandatory tour. Cost is approximately US\$3000. Not covered by our fee.
