Purpose of Short Term Exchange

- Promote international peace, goodwill & understanding, through 6 week family to family exchange
- Students experience world travel, cultural exchange

Applicant Qualifications

- Students 15- 18 yrs. of age (cannot turn 19 before you leave)
- Can come from Rotary & non-Rotary families
- Well rounded students who are open to new ideas & experiences- will serve as ambassadors of their community & Canada
- Must abide by Rotary Youth Exchange Rules

Cost

- U.S. dollars \$ 500.00
includes medical/travel insurance,
orientation & administrative costs
- Half due by Nov 15/ half due in May

Cost

- Other costs:
 - Airfare
 - Passport
 - Modest gift host family
 - Spending money
 - Room/board, recreational and sightseeing costs when hosting foreign student

Orientation

- Student and at least one parent attend Short term orientation meeting –
May

Applicant Responsibilities

- Complete application and country preference form and deliver to Rotary representative-**deadline September 30**
- Rotary club interview with parent(s)
- Learn about country you are visiting
- Get passport
- Attend required orientation meeting

Parent Responsibilities

- Be willing and able to host foreign student
- Be willing and able to provide recreational & sightseeing opportunities
- Pay \$250 USD– deadline November 15
- Pay \$250 USD– at orientation in May
- Attend required orientation meeting.
