- Students are matched based on age, gender, country preference and interests
- Exchanges are between District 5080 students and students from Europe & South America

Purpose of Short Term Exchange

- Promote world peace, goodwill & understanding through 60 day family-to-family exchange
- Students experience world travel, cultural exchange

Applicant Qualifications

- Students 15-19 years of age
- Can come from Rotary & non-Rotary families
- Well-rounded students who are open to new ideas & experiences who will serve as ambassadors for their community & country
- Must abide by Rotary Youth Exchange rules

Costs

- \$500US
- Includes medical/travel insurance
- Orientation
- Administrative costs
- First half (\$250US) due March 1st
- Remaining (\$250US) due a May orientation camp

Costs - continued

- Airfare
- Modest gift for host family
- Spending money
- Room/board, recreational & sightseeing costs when hosting foreign student

Orientation

- Student & at least one parent must attend weekend orientation the first weekend of May at Camp Lutherhaven near Coeur d'Alene, Idaho

Applicant Responsibilities

- Complete application & country preference form & deliver to your Rotary representative by March 1st
- Rotary club/District interview with parents
- Learn about country you are visiting
- Get passport
- Attend required orientation

Parent Responsibilities

- Be willing to host a foreign exchange student
- Be willing and able to provide recreational sightseeing opportunities
- Pay \$250US by March 1st & \$250US by the May orientation
- Attend May orientation camp
